

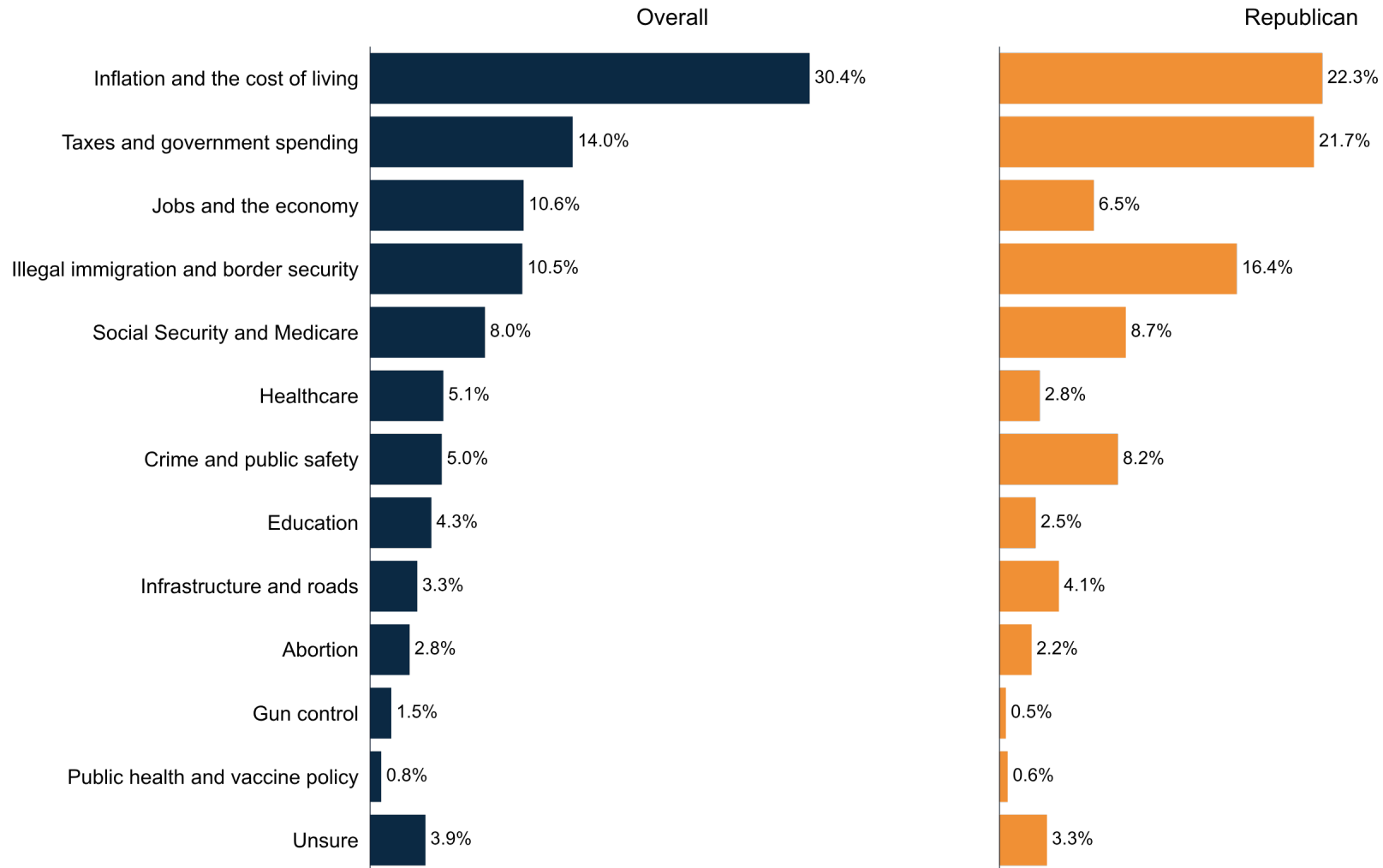

Which one of the following issues is the most important to you in the election for state legislature?

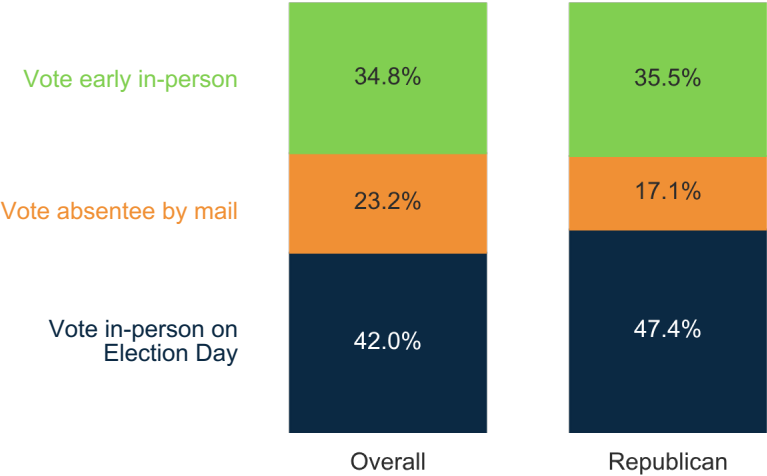

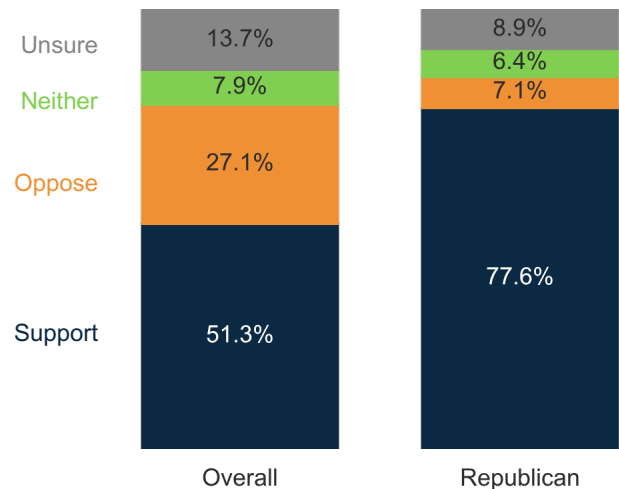

How do you plan to vote in the November 3rd general election for Governor, state legislature, and other statewide offices?

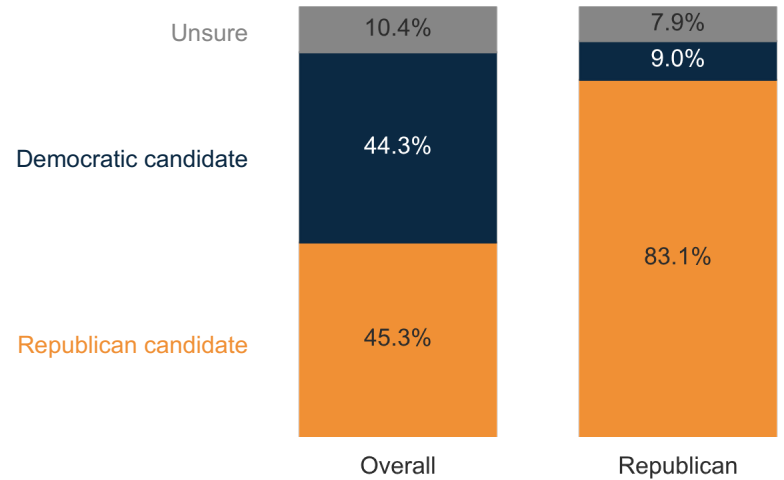

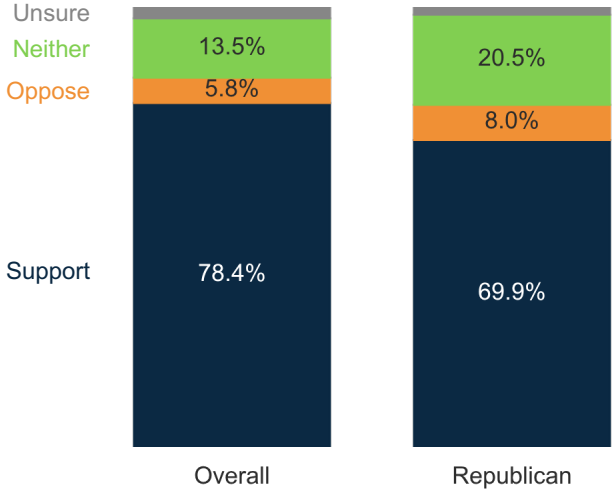

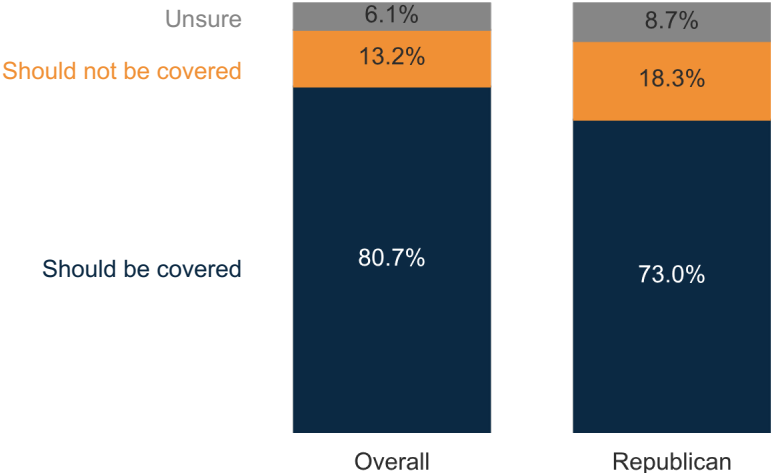

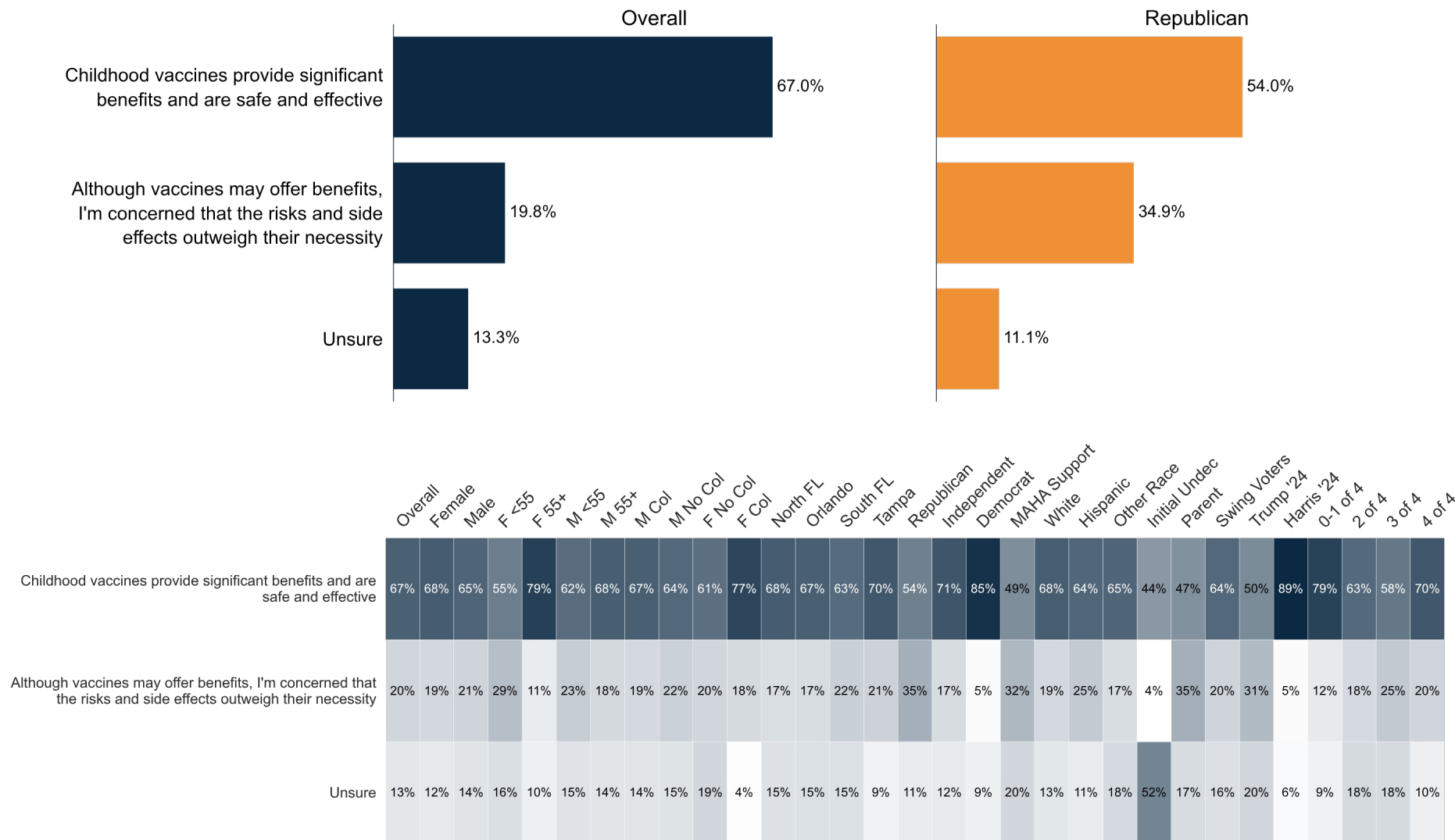

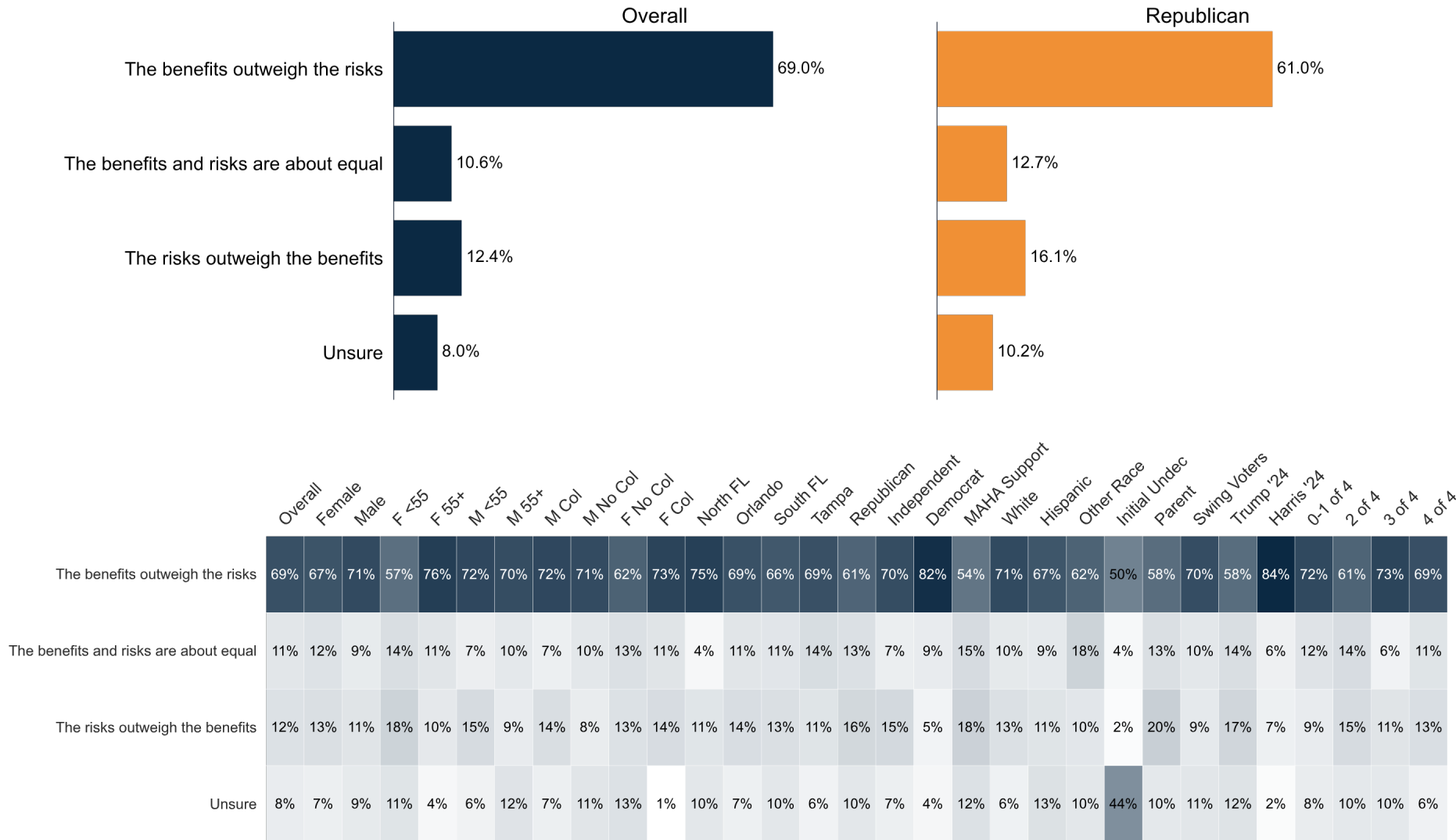

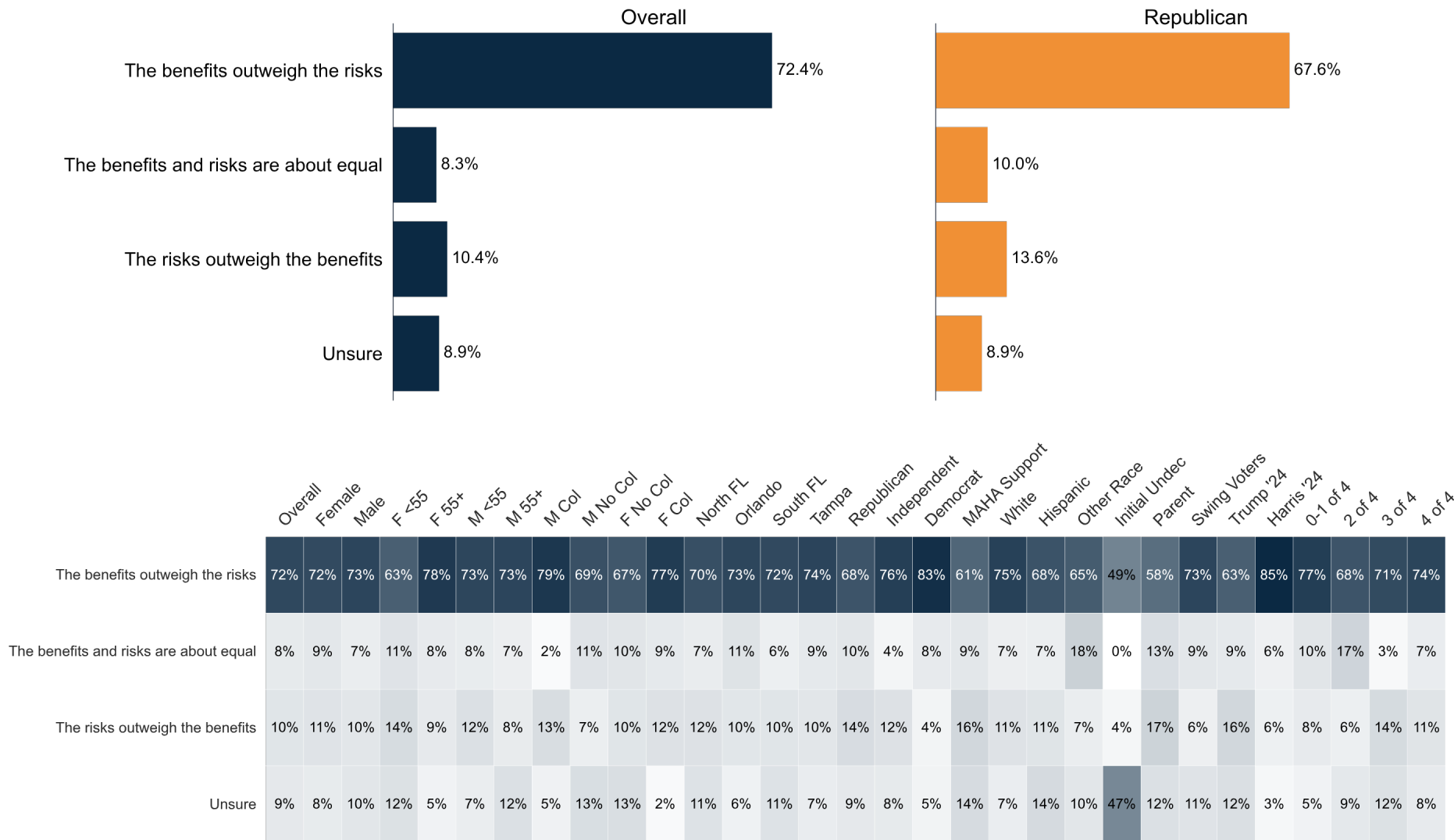

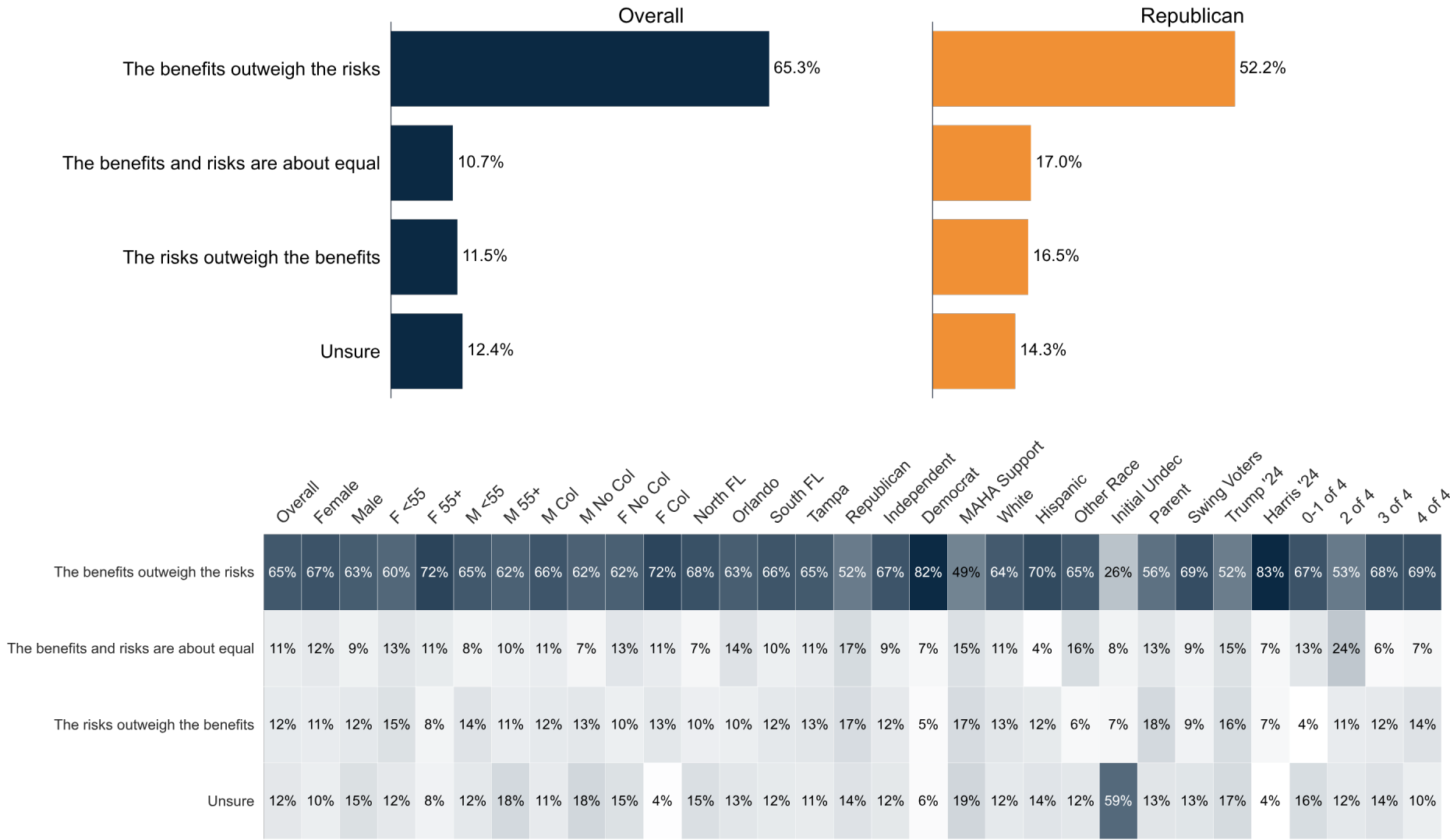

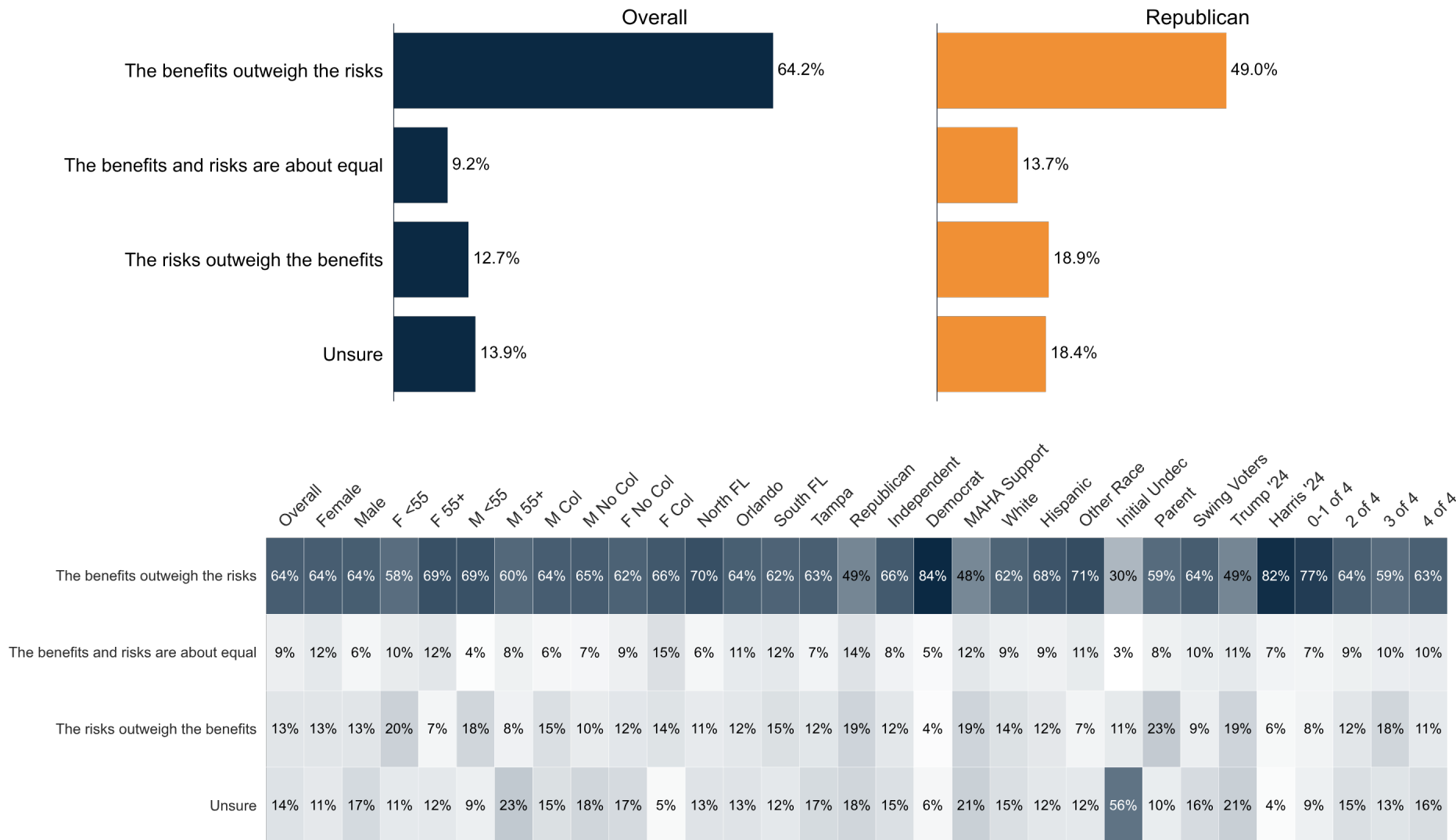

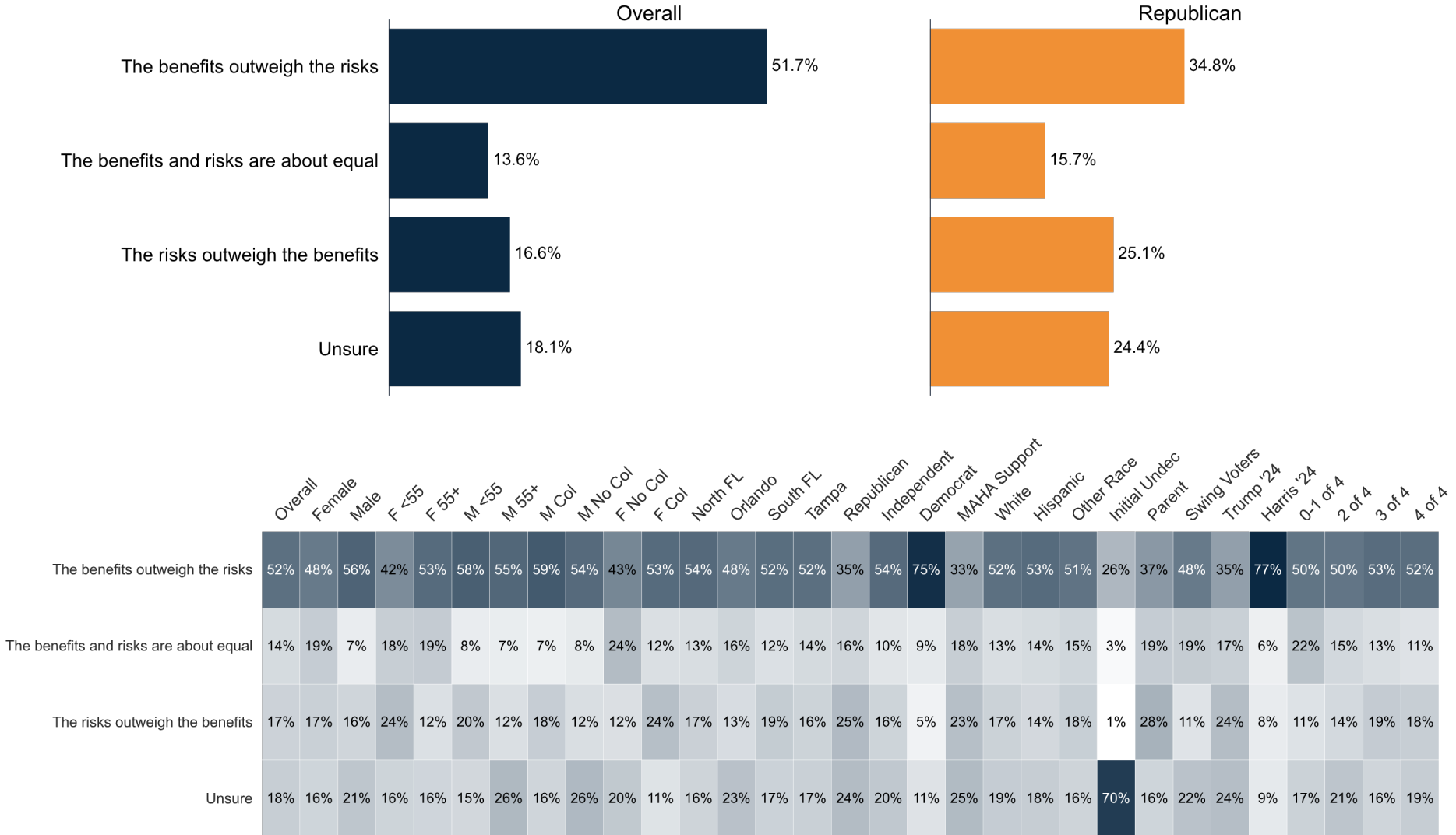

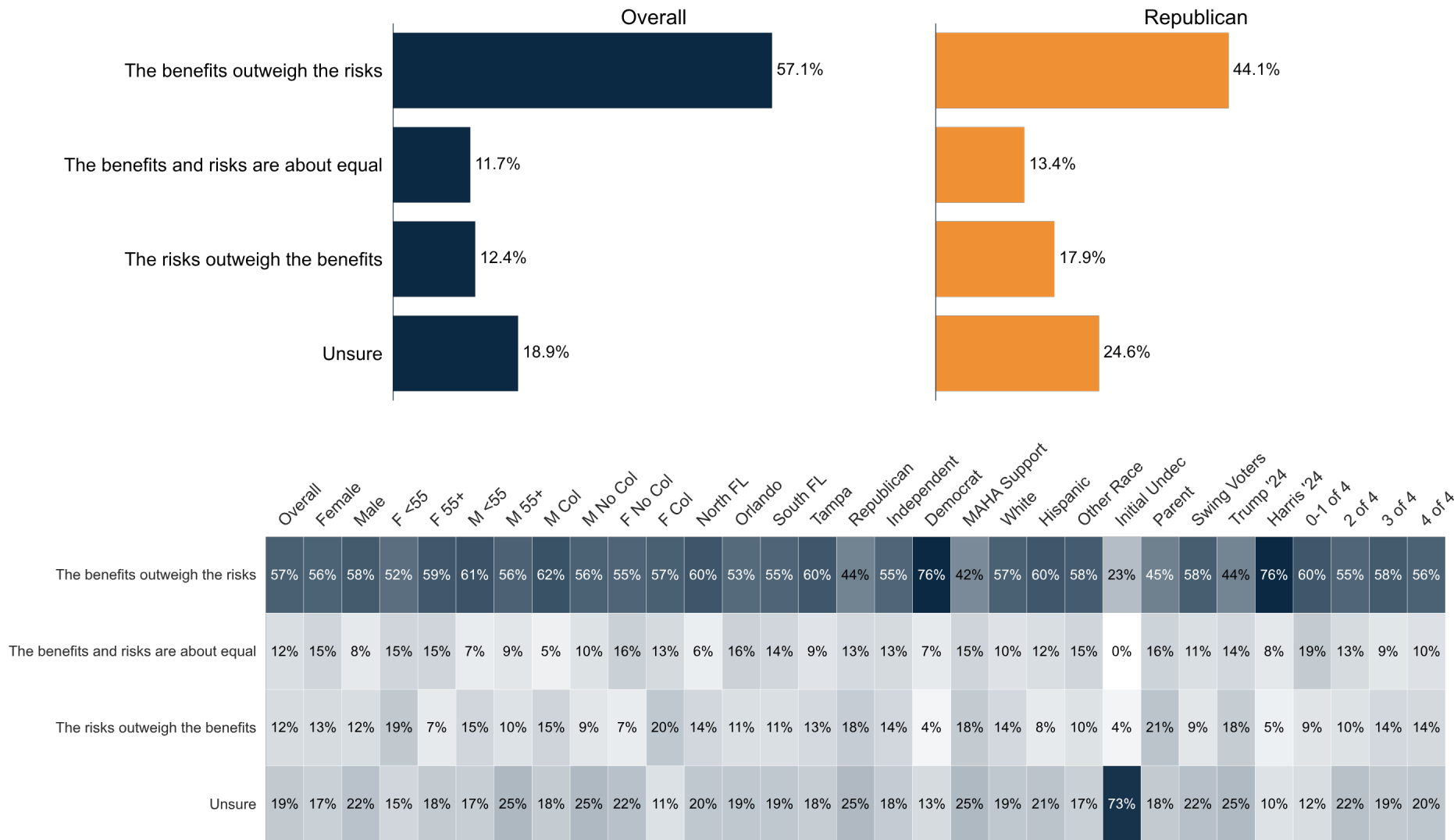

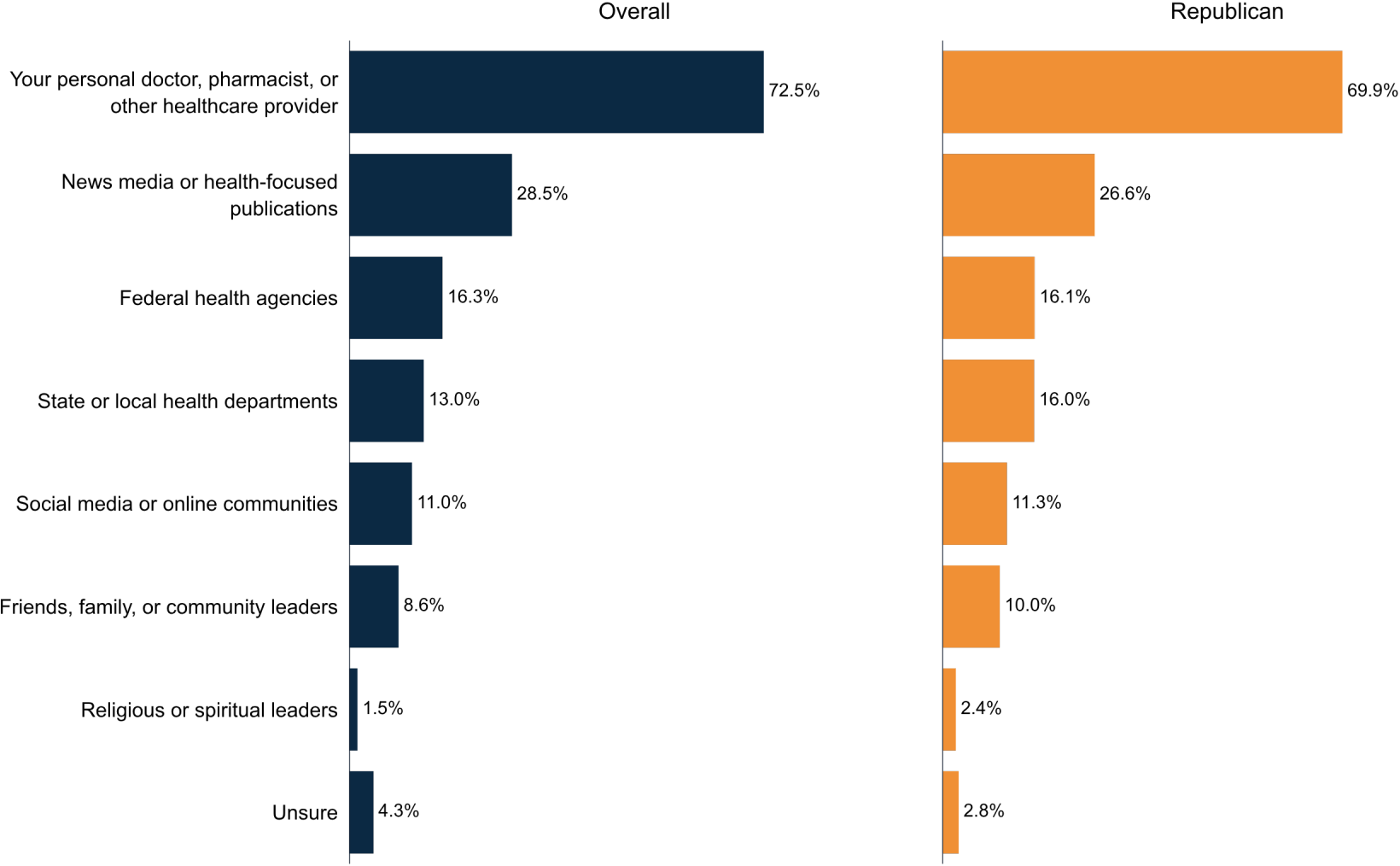

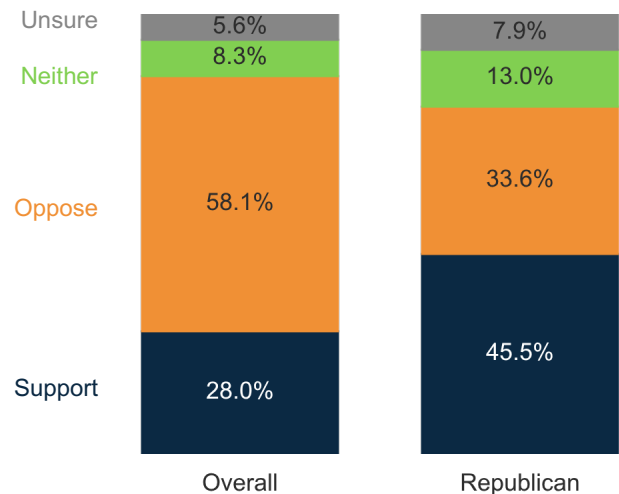

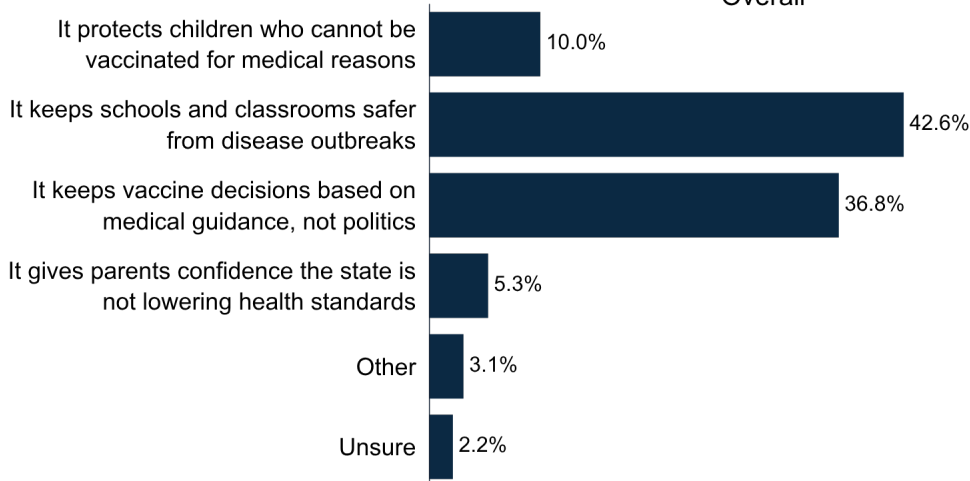

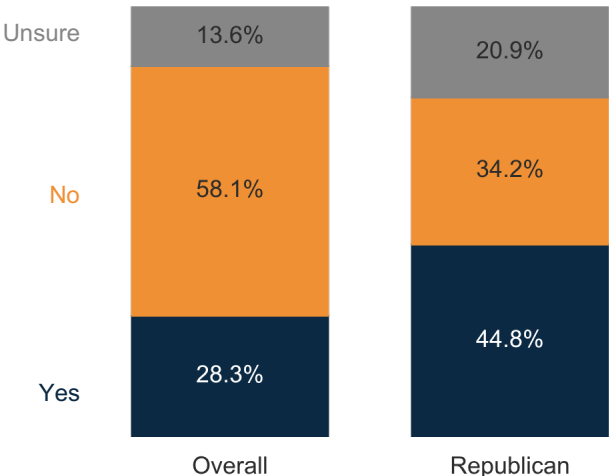
